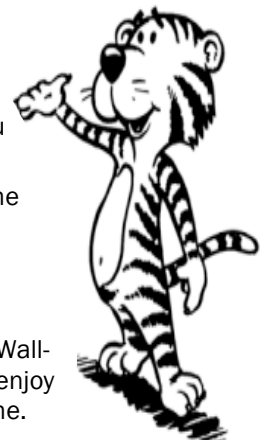
TIGER PAWS

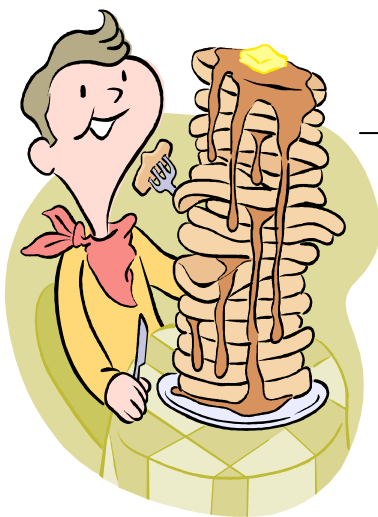
LET'S GO CAMPING!!

KENNEDY SPACE CENTER- OVERNIGHT ADVENTURE!

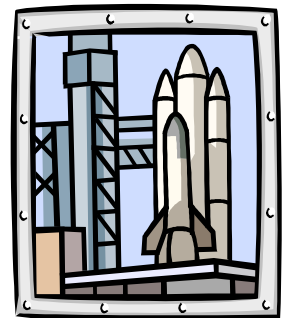
