CHURCH WORKDAY

On Saturday, April 20, 35 church family members spent from 8:00 – 2:00 working on different areas of the church. Inside, baseboards and floors were cleaned. In the Sanctuary, woodwork was cleaned; pews were washed and treated with lemon oil; brass was polished. Outside, limbs were trimmed; landscape plants installed; pine straw spread and wheel stops painted yellow or blue. Next door at 301 E. Tharpe, a level walkway replaced one that was uneven and a fall opportunity. The Trustees so appreciate the time and effort given by these people.

LADYBUGS ARRIVE IN MOSAIC GARDEN

The Ladybug Jubilee was one of many JOY-filled events at Saint Paul's Easter activities the day before Easter Sunday. Many children learned the value of ladybugs as they helped the Creation Care Team release 5,000 ladybugs into the Mosaic Garden. These beneficial insects eat aphids which can suck the juices out of plant stems. With them around, our tomato plants should survive and thrive. We can already see plenty of little yellow flowers which signal that the tomatoes are not far behind. The children had fun making ladybug headbands, decorating ladybug rocks, using magnifying glasses to get a closeup look, and spraying a sweet solution onto the plants to encourage the bugs to stay in the garden. Faith Presbyterian Church has dedicated a building on the back side of their campus & many renovations, coupled with our partnership with Second Harvest of the Big Bend, have enabled us to effectively utilize our space to serve more families more frequently. **In the first quarter of this year, we assisted nearly 3,500 individuals across over 1,100 households.** In comparison, we served 735 households during the first quarter of 2023. 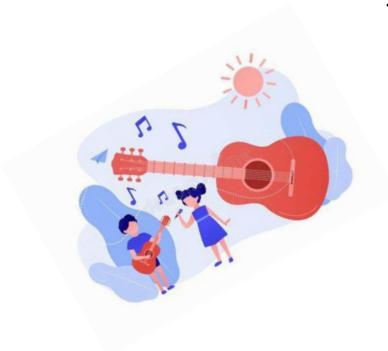
